In this connection, the Government has informed Directorate of Technical Education to instruct all institutions to form an Anti-Drugs Club/Committee at each institution involving their teachers and students and to send the Action taken Report to DOTE.

The Committee should be responsible for creating awareness amongst students against drug abuse. The above committee should ensure that the institution premises and surroundings are maintained free of drugs. Any information regarding availability of narcotic drugs should be passed to Narcotic Intelligence Bureau, CID Unit or local police. The Committee should work with the ultimate aim of achieving the status of Narcotic drugs free campus in their University / College. It is also informed that Narcotic Intelligence Bureau, CID Unit will be willing to render necessary assistance in this regard.

Hence, all the Principals are requested to form an Anti-Drugs Club / Committee at college campus involving your teachers and students and send the Action Taken Report to E-mail ID socdc.dote@tn.gov.in to submit the same to the Government immediately.

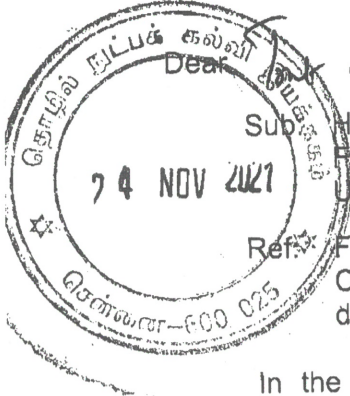
